

KAYA Celebrates 7 years in business

Huntsville, AL – May 5, 2010 – KAYA Associates, Inc. hosted a 7-year anniversary celebration on Wednesday, May 5 at their corporate headquarters in Huntsville. While many businesses are reducing their workforce, KAYA is expanding in 2010. “In the next three months, we will be adding over 50 new positions due to recent contract wins. We hope to add more employees by the end of the year,” said Robert Dunn, Chief Operating Officer. KAYA recently doubled the size of the corporate headquarters to accommodate the increasing workload.

KAYA is an SBA-certified 8(a) Small Disadvantaged Business (SDB) headquartered in Huntsville and offices in Hawaii, Alaska, Kentucky, and South Carolina.
